Mannheim School

Mannheim school is a term describing both the orchestral techniques developed by the court orchestra of Mannheim in the 18th century as well as the group of composers of the early classical period, who composed for the orchestra of Mannheim. The father of the school is considered to be the Johann Stamitz. A feature of their music was a new performance style which included new dynamic elements, crescendos and
