Hip-Hop

Hip hop music is a style of music started in the United States during the mid- 1970s, and became a large part of modern pop culture during the 1980s. It consists of two main components: rapping (MCing) and DJing (production and scratching). Along with hip hop dance (breakdancing) and street art (notably graffiti), these are the four elements of the cultural movement of hip hop.
