Björk (pronounced Beyerk) is a classically trained pianist and vocalist who released her first album, Björk (1977), as a tween. She then went on to play in the '80s post-punk band Tappi Tikarrass, and she co-helmed vocals for the Icelandic art-rock band the Sugarcubes before becoming the powerhouse performer she is now.
